### 1. WHO CAN APPLY?

## We will accept applications from:

Registered charities, not for profit organisations, informal groups and voluntary groups.

# Middlewich Town Council will not accept applications from:

- Limited companies/Businesses
- Organisations with only one bank account signatory (excluding informal one-off residents groups).
- Organisations who exclude anyone for reasons of sex, race, disability or religion unless it can be demonstrated that the project or service is allowed to provide a restricted service e.g. Women's Refuge facilities.

### 2. WHAT CAN YOU APPLY FOR?

We are flexible on what the funding can be used for but good examples of what will be given priority include:

- Formal fees and overheads (excluding wages and personal expenses). These may include e.g. Road Closure Fees
- Refreshments/beverages
- Bunting, tableware, party items, sundry items
- Entertainment
- Materials for e.g. crafts, activities on the day

#### 3. WHEN CAN YOU APPLY?

- Applications are open from 17<sup>th</sup> February 2022
- All applications will be formally assessed by the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022
- All applicants will be informed of the outcome of their grant by the 5<sup>th</sup> April 2022 (or earlier)
- Only one grant can be allocated per party
- If less than 20 applications are received, the extra funding will be evenly distributed to those who have had an application approved.

- There is a total of 20 x £100 grants available for Middlewich Street Parties. Once all grants are allocated and the funding stream exhausted, the funding stream will be closed.
- Grant applicants will be accepted on a first come, first served basis (as long as the grant applicants meet the criteria)
